
Good corporate governance protects and balances all stakeholder interests, strengthens business relationships, increases access to external financing, and leads to better operational performance.

ASSOCIATE MEMBER (AICD)

- At least college graduate
- Attended a cumulative 8 hrs of accredited ICD courses
- Recommendation from a Graduate Member, Regular Member, or Fellow; and,
- Passed due diligence

GRADUATE MEMBER (GICD)

- At least college graduate
- Completed the Corporate Governance Orientation Program (CGOP) and Professional Directors Program (PDP)
- Passed the PDP mini exams

EXPERIENCED-BASED (MICD)

- By invitation by bonafide ICD member or application
- Has at least 5 years relevant experience in any of the following:
 - Board Directorship;
 - Associate or full professorship in corporate governance in a reputable institution; or
 - Corporate
 Governance practice
 (e.g. Corporate
 Secretary,
 Compliance Officer,
 Chief Risk Officer);

FELLOW (FICD)

- At least college graduate
- Two (2) years of board directorship within the last 10 years.
- Completion of Corporate Governance Orientation Program (CGOP) and -Professional Directors Program (PDP)
- Passed the PDP exam and panel interview

LIFE FELLOW (FICD)

- Regular member in good standing for twenty (20) consecutive years, with at least ten (10) consecutive years as Fellow; or
- Fellow who has served 3 consecutive terms or 9 consecutive years as Trustee; or
- Fellow who meets other qualifications and accomplishments as may be approved by ICD Board

HONORARY FELLOW (FICD)

The title of Honorary Fellow may be bestowed by the ICD Board to distinguished personalities, in recognition of their significant contributions to corporate governance advocacy.

Note: Each category is subject to applicable approval process by the Fellows Committee and Board of Trustees.

Your application will be recommended for the approval of Fellows Committee and the Board of Trustees.

CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP

Qualifications and Requirements

- SEC Registration
- Current year's General Information Sheet (GIS)
- Current year's Income Tax
- Corporate Profile Annual Report and Website, if any
- Corporate representatives must be a board member and/or a C-Level executive of the company
- Corporate representatives must attend at least 8 hours of ICD accredited courses in the previous year to retain their membership.
- CVs of representatives

Procedure

- Company must submit accomplished Corporate Membership Application and pass due diligence checking and panel interview.
- After passing due diligence checking and panel interview, application will undergo applicable approval process.

Tenure of Corporate Membership

Corporate Representatives will remain as the bonafide representatives of the corporate member as long as:

- The company is a corporate member in good standing,
- The company has retained him or her as its representative, and
- He/She has attended at least 8 hours of accredited ICD courses in the previous year.

Annual Membership Fee

Php 60,000 with 3 representatives

+ Php 15,000 for each additional representative


